🚗 Travel tips

Uber/99 (ride apps) work very well in Brasília. They're safe and there are always drivers available.

If you prefer, renting a car is also a good option, especially for visiting places that are farther away.

The city is safe and well designed, which makes getting around much easier.

📍 What to Do in Brasília

🏛️ Architecture, History & Culture

- **University of Brasília -UNB (Universidade de Brasília)** ⌚ 30min–1h
It's worth visiting the campus, a national reference in architecture and education.
- **JK Memorial** – ⌚ 1h
A museum honoring the city's founder of Brasilia: Juscelino Kubitschek.
- **Metropolitan Cathedral (Catedral Metropolitana)** – ⌚ 30min
A masterpiece by Oscar Niemeyer!
- **National Museum of the Republic (Museu Nacional da República)** – ⌚ 1h
Free entry, iconic architecture, and several exhibitions.
- **National Congress + National Congress Palace (Congresso Nacional + Palácio do Congresso Nacional)** – ⌚ 1h–1h30
Guided tours are available. Booking in advance is recommended.
- **Three Powers Square (Praça dos Três Poderes)** – ⌚ 30min
Here you can see the Planalto Palace, the Supreme Court, and Congress. It's the political heart of the country..

- **Itamaraty Palace (Palácio Itamaraty)** – ⌚ 1h
Headquarters of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, with indoor gardens and guided visits.
- **Brasília TV Tower + Craft Market (Torre de TV de Brasília + Feirinha)** – ⌚ 1h
Great for souvenirs and a panoramic view of the city.
- **Digital TV Tower (Torre de TV Digital)** – ⌚ 30min
Best visited in daylight, amazing views!
- **Catetinho** – ⌚ 30min
Juscelino Kubitschek (JK)'s first official residence, full of histor.
- **Living Museum of Candango Memory (Museu Vivo da Memória Candanga)** – ⌚ 1h
Tells the story of the city's first inhabitants (the "candangos").
- **Temple of Good Will (Templo da Boa Vontade)** – ⌚ 30min
A place of peace and spirituality, open to all religions.
- **Little Church of Our Lady of Fátima (Igrejinha Nossa Senhora de Fátima)** – ⌚ 20min
A small, charming church designed by Niemeyer.

🌿 Nature, Leisure & Outdoor Activities

- **Pontão do Lago Sul** – ⌚ 1h–2h
An area with restaurants and a lakeside promenade to walk around and relax, perfect in the late afternoon.
- **Lakeside near the JK Bridge (Orla da Ponte JK)** – ⌚ 1h
Ideal for families; activities include stand-up paddleboarding and swimming areas.
- **Sarah Kubitschek City Park (Parque da Cidade Sarah Kubitschek)** – ⌚ 1h–2h
Perfect for a picnic or a leisurely walk.
- **Brasília Zoo (Zoológico de Brasília)** – ⌚ 1h30–2h
A good option for children and families.
- **Nicolândia Center Park** – ⌚ 2h
Amusement park.
- **Brasília Planetarium (Planetário de Brasília)** – ⌚ 1h
Lots of fun for kids and curious adults!
- **Brasília Drive-In Cinema (Cine Drive-In de Brasília)** – ⌚ 2h
One of the last in the country (**ABSOLUTELY NOT SUITABLE FOR CHILDREN**). Great for anyone who's never had a spicy outdoor "movie-theater atmosphere" experience. 😊
- **Saia Velha Pool a bit farther from Brasilia (Saia Velha Piscina)** – ⌚ 3h–4h
Ideal if you want to enjoy a pool surrounded by nature. We recommend going by car/Uber/99.
